published proposed amendments to the Cathedral Constitution and Statutes for the purpose of complying with the Cathedrals Measure 2021 – Amendment of Governing Instruments

Summary of the nature of the amendments

To comply with the requirements of the Cathedrals Measure 2021 providing co-regulation of Cathedrals by the Charity Commission of England and Wales and the Church Commissioners bringing them under the Charities Act. The draft Constitution and Statutes provides for a clear governance structure, separating governance and management activities. It provides clarity over the roles and responsibilities of those involved in Cathedrals. It provides for better, professional control of finance, risk, and audit, clarifying issues of property ownership and has safeguarding at its heart.
